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


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Martin Luther King Jr Facts

Michael King Jr. was born on January 15, 1929, in Atlanta, Georgia, US.

On July 23, 1957, at 28, he changed his name to Martin Luther King Jr. since the name on his original birth certificate needed to be corrected. He was supposed to be named after his father - Martin Luther.



He was an American Baptist minister and activist.

Also, one of the most prominent leaders in the civil rights movement.

He was the Son of early civil rights activist and minister Martin Luther King Sr.

Martin Luther King Jr Facts

Dr. King fought for equality and human rights for people of color in the United States. He is also well known for his speech, "I Have a Dream," which he delivered during the March in Washington. In it, he said:

"I HAVE A DREAM THAT ONE DAY THIS NATION WILL RISE UP AND LIVE OUT THE TRUE MEANING OF ITS CREED: "WE HOLD THESE TRUTHS TO BE SELF-EVIDENT, THAT ALL MEN ARE CREATED EQUAL."

He was highly influenced by Mahatma Gandhi's non-violent approach to protests.

King participated in and led marches for the right to vote, desegregation, labor rights, and other civil rights.

Martin Luther King Jr Facts



In his book, *Stride Towards Freedom*, King listed down his six principles of non-violence:

- Non-violence is a way of life for courageous people.
- Non-violence seeks to win friendship and understanding.
- Non-violence seeks to defeat injustice, not people.
- Non-violence holds that suffering can educate and transform.
- Non-violence chooses love instead of hate.
- Non-violence believes that the universe is on the side of justice.

King was the youngest person to be awarded the Noble Peace Prize in 1964.

He hoped that America and the world could become a society where people are not color blind but color kind.



Timeline of historic speeches



1963

Dr. King delivered his famous "I have a Dream" speech on the steps of the Lincoln memorial.

1965

At the end of the March from Selma to Montgomery on March 25, 1965 Martin Luther King delivered his speech, "How Long, Not Long."

1968

On April 3, 1968, Martin Luther King, Jr., gave his last speech -- "I've been to the Mountaintop."
He addressed sanitation workers on strike in Memphis, Tennessee

1967

On March 25, 1967, he gave his first major speech on the war in Vietnam. His speech was titled "Beyond Vietnam."
