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






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Here are some suggested ways to use the scavenger hunt.

- Green Clover Leaves: Cut out or find fake green clover leaves and hide them around the area.
- Leprechaun Hat: Pick up a small leprechaun hat at your local dollar store or hide a cut out of a Leprechaun hat.
- Gold Coins: Use chocolate gold coins or plastic gold coins as treasures to find.

  If you are using chocolate gold coins kids can keep the chocolate.
  - Rainbow Colors: Print and cut out a rainbow.
  - St. Patrick's Day Decorations: Hide banners, and other St. Patrick's Day decorations. (dollar store)
- Leprechaun Footprints: Create footprints with green washable paint or cut them out of paper and place them along the route.
  - ♥Irish Flags: Use small Irish flags or print and cut them out.
  - Pot of Gold: A small pot filled with gold-wrapped chocolates or candies.
